- From August 12-22, the Smithsonian Environmental Research Center used school facilities, including the science labs and hatchery, while conducting a “scientific study of exotic organisms” in the waters around Unalaska/Dutch Harbor. Project leaders reported that their work in Unalaska was one of their most positive field experiences ever during this study, due in large part to the fine science lab facility at Unalaska school.
