The Board of Education of the Unalaska City School District met in the high school library in Unalaska on Thursday, May 23, 2002. Board President, Tammy Fowler Pound, called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Guests were introduced.

The Board took the following actions:

- Received an update on the 2002 Graduation Festivities.
- Adopted the Science, Social Studies, Vocational Education, and ESL Curricula as presented.
- Received an update on the K-12 Aleut Language/Culture Curriculum.
- Approved the FY 03 Student Handbook.
- Heard an update on the Strategic Plan.
- Approved FY 03 teaching contracts for Machel Kelchner and Kelly Quinn.
- Heard an update on the FY 03 budget. Through the final actions taken by the legislature last week, UCSD will receive an additional \$96,020 in funding from the state. Unfortunately, this increase in funding is just for one year, and the amount will drop back to this year's level for the following year.
- Approved a 10% increase in breakfast and lunch prices for FY 03, and the adult salad bar price will be the same as the regular lunch price. The new prices will be as follows: \$1.10 for K-6 Breakfast, \$2.20 for 7-12 Breakfast, \$2.20 for K-6 Lunch, \$2.75 for 7-12 Lunch, \$2.75 for 5-12 Salad Bar, \$4.95 for Adult Lunch and \$4.95 for Adult Salad Bar.
- Set the preschool tuition rate for FY 03 at FY 02's level.
- Approved the following grants:
 - No Child Left Behind
 - Title I-A
 - Title III
 - Title V-A (including REAP)
 - Title VI-B
 - 619 Preschool Disabled
 - Preschool Disabled Summer School
 - Toyota Time Grant
 - High Intensity Summer Reading
 - Community School
 - Carl Perkins
