The Board of Education of the Unalaska City School District met in the High School Library in Unalaska on Thursday, May 20, 2004. Board President, Tammy Fowler Pound, called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

The Board took the following actions:

- Thanked former Mayor Pam Fitch for being an advocate for children.
- Approved the April 22, 2004 School Board Meeting minutes.
- Approved the Preschool Curriculum. Heard a report on the curriculum review cycle for reading, writing, and math for the upcoming year.
- Heard a report on the DEED Special Education and Federal Program Review.
- Reviewed the draft of the Indian Policies and Procedures for the Impact Aid Grant.
- Approved the 2004-2005 teacher contract for Sean Reilly.
- Heard a legislative update.
- Heard a budget update. With the additional funding from the State and increased local funding cap, gave approval to add an English as a Second Language Teacher and increase the District Administrative Assistant's hours from four to six hours per day for FY 05. Directed administration to decrease the total request to the city by \$55,147.
- Approved the Community Schools Agreement with the City of Unalaska for the 2004-2005 school year.
- Approved a contract with Altman, Rogers & Co. for the June 30, 2004 audit.
- Approved the second reading of the following Board policies and the following Board Administrative Regulation:
 - BP 0430 Community School Program
 - BP 0520 School Accountability/School Improvement
 - AR 0520 School Accountability/School Improvement
 - BP 0530 Discontinuation or Closure of Schools
 - BP 3541 Transportation Routes and Services
- Approved the April FY 04 financials.
- Approved the FY 04 Budget Revision.
